Dear Madam or Sir,

enclosed is our current statement on Directive 2012/19 / EU (WEEE) or Electrical Act (ElektroG) as the implementation of the EU directive into national law. SSP products are not electrical or electronic devices in the sense of WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment) and

- are not sold to private households (B2C)
- are not components that function on their own for control and regulation
- do not fall into the 10/6 categories of Annexes I to IV of the Regulation
- do not fall into the open categories of the regulation from August 2018

SSP customers who manufacture devices in accordance with WEEE

- are supported in the sense of WEEE
- receive a marking of SSP products according to Annex IX (garbage can symbol) on request
- are solely responsible for the registration of their products within the meaning of WEEE

SSP will continue to follow the implementation of the regulation in terms of content, adapt the internal guidelines if the scope or content of the regulation changes, actively follow the interpretation of the regulation and dispose of electronic waste from its own sources in accordance with the law.
